<b>CITY OF SAN DIEGO</b>	<b>A</b>  Majority - Required to pass	<b>CHARTER AMENDMENT AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR AND AUDIT COMMITTEE TO USE OUTSIDE LEGAL COUNSEL INSTEAD OF THE ELECTED CITY ATTORNEY.</b> Shall Charter section 40 be amended and section 40.2 be added to authorize the City Auditor and Audit Committee to use outside legal counsel instead of the elected City Attorney, subject to certain conditions, when the Audit Committee determines such use is in the public interest? <b>Supporters:</b> Councilmember Vivian Moreno; Assemblymember David Alvarez; Andy Hanau; Elaine Howle; Assoc. of Local Government Auditors. <b>Opponents:</b> Clifford Weiler.
<b>MOUNTAIN EMPIRE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT</b>	<b>B</b>  55% Required to pass	To repair, replace, or reconstruct deteriorating classrooms, science labs, and school facilities at Mountain Empire High School that don't meet building safety/earthquake safety standards; replace/fix roofs, plumbing, sewer, electrical, and aging portables; and improve school safety/security systems, shall Mountain Empire Unified School District's measure authorizing \$20,000,000 in bonds, at legal rates, be adopted, levying approximately \$40 per \$100,000 of assessed value (averaging \$1,253,097 annually) while bonds are outstanding, with citizen oversight, independent audits, and all money staying local? <b>Supporters:</b> Board Pres. <b>RINCON RANCH COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT</b>	<b>C</b>  2/3 Required to pass	Shall the Rincon Ranch Community Services District be authorized to establish and levy a Special Tax Override, on all taxable real property within its boundaries for the purpose of providing funds for repair and resurface of the roads maintained by the District, with this Special Tax not to exceed ten dollars per acre, or portion thereof, plus two hundred fifty dollars per parcel of land per year? <b>Supporters:</b> None submitted. <b>Opponents:</b> None submitted.
